TOURNAMENT NEWS:

Sanctioned Events:

- The maximum average number of games per day over the duration of a tournament is two. One day tournaments are exempt from this rule.
- 18+ Open Provincial players may play as a substitute for two tournaments in a season. Any player that appears on more than two T.R.F. Adjustment Forms constitutes violation of Sanction Rules (goaltender exempt), unless written Games and Tournaments approval is received.

U12 Petite Provincial Event:

- ***Oshawa Goes to the Zoo - The Roar of the Ring!*** Up to 12 U12 Petite Regional teams will be included in this event. All regional teams wishing to attend must register via the on line intent to proceed registration form by ***November 20, 2014.***

Provincial Events:

- **NEW THIS SEASON:** AA - if there are 12 teams or fewer in a division, they will play together in an unbalanced format. If there are 13 teams the division will be split into two (2) tiers based on rankings with seven (7) teams in the top tier and six (6) teams in the lower tier. The two tiers will be independent of each other and there will be no crossover between tiers.
- **ALL PROVINCIAL EVENTS** - In a division with less than 8 teams, the top three teams will advance to the medal round: Bronze medal game – 3rd ranked versus 2nd
Gold medal game – 1st versus winner of Bronze medal game
- **ONLINE INTENT TO PROCEED TO PROVINCIALS LINK** is now available on the ORA website and must be completed by midnight on **November 20, 2014** (*REMINDER* - this is in addition to the hard copy of the intent to proceed to provincials that includes signatures that must be submitted along with the team registration fees as per regional deadline).
