BENCH STAFF QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2012/2013:

- Qualification requirements for the individual bench staff positions remain
 unchanged for this season; however, there is a new requirement in effect
 this season that requires all U9 to U19 teams to have at least one bench staff
 member who has First Aid Certification (as defined in Paragraph 4.7 of the
 Coaching Development Section of the ORA Operating Manual). It is highly
 recommended that this person be present at all games and team activities.
 This person does not have to have the title of 'Trainer'; it could be one of the
 Coaches on the team.
- The bench staff qualification requirements chart has been expanded to include the U6 level and requires that the Head Coach of a U6 program be CSI (Community Sport Initiation) Trained.
- A reminder that all coaches must become MED (Make Ethical Decisions)
 Certified. An MED training module is included in both the CSI and CI
 (Competition Introduction) clinics. After attending a CSI or CI clinic, coaches become MED certified by completing an online evaluation (quiz) on the
 Coaching Association of Canada website. Coaches who completed a CSI or CI clinic prior to June 30, 2012, must successfully complete the online evaluation by January 8, 2013. Coaches who

COACHING CLINICS:

- The National Coaches' Certification Program for the training and certification of Ringette
 coaches has been developed by the Coaching Association of Canada and Ringette Canada. The
 relevant coaching clinics Community Sport Initiation (CSI) and Competition Introduction (CI-1
 and CI-2) are offered in each region. Please consult your Regional website for important
 information regarding the delivery of the clinics in your area. Clinic dates are also posted on the
 ORA website.
- Registration for clinics is done through the Ringette Canada National Coach Registry System. All
 coaches are encouraged to create a profile on this system. In addition to giving you the ability to
 register for clinics, you will have access to various coaching resources, including sample practice
 plans and demonstration videos, as well as updates from Ringette Canada. Check it out at
 www.coachingringette.ca and click on 'Register Now' to create your profile.
