#### MEMBERSHIP RIGHTS AND VOTING PROCEDURES

- (i) Each Registered Member shall have a vote on each question arising at any special or general meeting of the members.
- (ii) Registered Members shall designate their voting delegates prior to the Annual General Meeting by issuing an authorization. A Registered Member may appoint as their delegate an individual who shall be a member of the Registered Member Association to attend and act at the meeting on behalf of the Registered Member. The President or Secretary or like official of a Registered Member Association shall sign the written notice authorizing the said delegate to represent the Registered Member at Meetings of the O.R.A. Registration of the delegate shall be accepted until the commencement of the Meeting.
- (iii) No delegate shall vote for more than one registered member.
- (iv) No Member shall be entitled to vote at Meetings of the O.R.A. unless he has paid all dues or fees payable by him as outlined by By-Law No.1 Article 23.
- (v) Associate and Honorary Life Members may attend Meetings of Members but their vote shall be carried by Regional Chair.
- (vi) If no delegate is appointed the Registered Members vote will be held by the Regional Chair.

### **ORA AGM CONFERENCE 2014**

#### **SEMINAR**

#### 1. Steve Indig – Ontario Not-For-Profit Act

Steve is a lawyer and was formerly a certified sports agent representing professional athletes. Steve has worked with over 400 national and provincial sport organizations providing consulting services relating to governance, employment, contracts, policies, disputes, and privacy. In addition, he has acted as an adjudicator on issues relating to eligibility, conduct of athletes, coaches and membership. Steve has significant first-hand knowledge of sport from competitive swimming at the national level, coaching and refereeing.

The Provincial Ontario Not-For-Profit
Corporations Act (ONCA) has received Royal Assent
and is expected to come into force early 2015. At that
time, all not-for-profit corporations, including the
Ontario Ringette Association and its incorporated
Clubs will have three years to transition from the
current Corporations Act to the new ONCA. This
presentation will provide an overview of the ONCA
and how it applies to incorporated and nonincorporated sport organizations. Participants will
gain an understanding of the ONCA and the required
steps to comply. In addition, the new ORA By-Laws
will be presented for discussion and review.

An open forum will be held immediately following the AGM to allow members to exchange ideas, network and discuss relevant issues on a wide range of topics.
